

Global Awareness Project for 11th Grade: France



What you will do:

You will create a colorful, engaging, and informative travel brochure to France by gathering information in each of your content area classes (math, science, economics, and English) between the days of Tuesday, 2/7 and Thursday, 2/16.

What the teachers will provide:

Depending on the teacher, you will be provided with articles, websites, lectures, or activities where you will be exposed to information relevant to France.

When it will be due and to whom do you submit it:

It will be due on Friday, 2/17 upon entering your English classrooms (either Ring or Clary)

Requirements:

- You must make a tri-fold brochure.
- It must be colorful and as professional looking as possible.
- Printing out pictures must be done on your time. Remember the computer lab is open Monday – Thursday in Mrs. Turgeon’s room after school.
- The front cover must have:
 - A title
 - A picture of a French notable person, landmark, scene, symbol, or landscape OR a collage of such
- The back cover must have:
 - Five facts about France that you looked up on your own
 - A map of France or of a major area, region, or city if you are narrowing your focus
 - YOUR NAME AT THE BOTTOM AS THE PUBLISHER
- You will have four panels in your brochure, one for each content area.
 - The Science panel: Scientists
 - Must have at least 7 factual items
 - Must provide a picture
 - The Math panel: Money Issues
 - Must have at least 7 factual items
 - Must have a picture
 - The Economics Panel: How to get around
 - Must have at least 7 factual items
 - Must have a picture
 - The English Panel: Museums
 - Must have at least 7 factual items
 - Must have a picture
